

## NA RÚIN (Motions) - An Comhdháil Bhliantúil 2020

1. That Longford GAA adopt the following BYE-LAW as allowed for under R. 6.21 (4) (c) T.O. 2020

Where 3 or more teams finish level on points at the conclusion of the round stages of a competition, the team which finishes top should be determined by the results between the three or more teams – i.e. winner of these games - if this is level it should then involve scoring difference from the matches between the 3 teams. If this also turns out to be level it should then go to overall scoring difference excluding the results involved with any team which may have been awarded a walkover in the competition.

2. That Longford GAA Bye Law No. 10 "Permissions to Play" be amended to read as follows:

Applications made under R. 3.19 (n) T.O. 2020 to avail of a provision of Rule 6.8 (C) and Exception (1) (a) or (b) shall be submitted for approval no later than  $30^{th}$  June each year. \*Note changes in Red

**3.** That Wednesday's of each week are reserved for hurling only in the county.

**4.** That if there are 3 teams in a Championship group where the top two team's progress a draw be made for the first game and the winner of this game will then play the remaining team in the group in the next game (round). This will prevent any potential incentive for teams to play for a particular result and gives each team in the group a fair chance of progression.
